Now in its 23rd year, Strings & Jazzy Things Summer Music Camp provides an opportunity for middle school students to work with professional musicians and music educators.


This tuition-free, intensive camp also includes lunch daily, an evening meal on Friday, 2 snacks each day, a t-shirt, and a final concert for parents.


